 - c. Scale accurate drawing showing location of all existing and proposed structures, walls, parking and drainage features
 - d. Location of ingress and egress
 - e. Height of retaining walls and at horizontal breaks along top of wall
- Submit a 911 address obtained from either the County or the Village (County, 575-648-2385 x138) (Village, 575-258-6999) (Village address certification included in review of application by Planning, Zoning & Building staff.)
- Submit a floodplain certification from the County if required (Curt Temple, 575-258-5934). Village floodplain certification included in review of application by Planning, Zoning & Building staff.
- 4. Submit evidence of compliance with storm water requirements (<u>https://www.epa.gov/npdes/npdes-stormwater-program</u>) (<u>www.nmenv.state.nm.us</u> or 505-827-2798)(<u>show drainage control to an approved location and erosion control on site plans</u>)
